



Charles William Cottrill

October 14, 1942 - February 8, 2018

Charles William “Bill” Cottrill, age 75, died peacefully surrounded by family at Hospice House, Bloomington, Indiana on February 8, 2018, after a 20-year battle with cancer. Bill is survived by wife Mary Lou Bloomington, Indiana; son Bill (Laurie) Naperville, Illinois; son Kevin (Laura) Seymour, Indiana; daughter Kim Breadmore (John) Cape Coral, Florida. He was preceded in death by mother, Helen K. Cottrill; Bloomington, Indiana; and father, Charles W. Cottrill, Akron, Ohio.

Bill was born on October 14, 1942 in Akron, Ohio and is an Army veteran. He married Mary Lou in 1967. After moving to Bloomington, Indiana, he began working for RCA and retired in 1998 with 33 years of service.
