January 6, 1953 - August 12, 2018

Paula J. Bates, 65, died August 12. She was born in Indianapolis in 1953 to Betty and Gene Sauer. She is survived by her husband of 32 years, Jack, their children, Amanda and Chris, and Amanda's fiancé, Mike Vitousek. She is also survived by her siblings, Diane Brow (Rick), Jeff Sauer (Lisa), and Larry Sauer (Alice), her brother-in-law Bob Bates (Vicki), and her nieces and nephews. Paula also leaves behind many dear friends. Paula's career was multifaceted, balancing, art, professional counseling, and motherhood. She was a painter who studied with a number of well-known Hoosier artists, co-founded a cooperative gallery in Bloomington (Gallery North on the Square), and exhibited her work in various places and shows in Bloomington, Nashville, Indianapolis, and Louisville. She maintained a private practice as licensed counselor in Bloomington. She published two novels. She was also a lifelong spiritual explorer. Her role as mother was the most important to her, and as part of that, she regularly volunteered in her children's schools. Paula lived largely in Bloomington, Indiana, but also lived for extended periods in San Francisco, Minneapolis, Eugene, OR, and New York City. She received her Bachelor's degree in psychology and Master's in counseling at Indiana University, Bloomington. For those who would like to remember her with a charitable contribution, Paula was a regular contributor to Hoosier Hills Food Bank, Nature Conservancy, National Museum of Women in the Arts, and the Monroe County Community Schools Foundation. Her family also greatly appreciated the care given her by IU Health Hospice. A Memorial Reception will be held Thursday, August 16, from 4 to 7 p.m. at Allen Funeral Home and Crematory, 4155 S.
