Agnes M. Milligan, 92 of Indianapolis, formerly of Bloomington, passed away Monday July 19, 2010 at the Westside Gardens Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Indianapolis. Agnes was one of eight children born to John D. and Marian Winning Milligan in Bloomington on July 31, 1917. She was a graduate of Bloomington High School and spent her professional career as a bookkeeper for The Feltus Printing company's Star-Courier newspaper and then for the Indiana University accounting department.
