Andrew Hall Lindsey, 32, loving son, brother, uncle, nephew, and cousin, passed away unexpectedly on Saturday, January 7. Andrew was born in Bloomington on June 25, 1990, to Bob and Valerie (Bouvier) Lindsey. He grew up in Bloomington, graduating with honors from Bloomington High School North. He earned a Bachelor of Science in Education and was inducted into Kappa Delta Pi International Honor Society in Education. Wooden Middle School in Martinsville, where he coached baseball. He was especially enjoying this year with his students and loved to talk about what he was doing in the classroom.
