Ann Louise Galm Duke, 96 of Bloomington, IN, formerly of Lakeview Circle in East Liverpool, OH passed away on Thursday, March 15, 2018.

She was born in East Liverpool on August 24, 1921 the daughter to the late Andrew L. Galm and Nina (Trenle) Galm. Ann Louise lived a great deal of her life in East Liverpool, with 20 years spent away in Richmond, IN and Louisville, KY. She graduated from East Liverpool High School in 1940 and was also a graduate of Grace Martin's Business College for women in Pittsburgh, PA.
