Anna L. (Taylor) Bruce, 93, of Bloomington, Indiana passed away on Monday, February 17, 2020 at Brown County Health and Living.

Anna was born in Stinesville, IN on July 17, 1926 to the late Samuel Earl and Shirley (Payton) Taylor. She attended Stinesville High School and graduated in 1944. Right after high school she went to work at RCA in Bloomington, manufacturing products for WWII. While still working for RCA, Anna met the love of her life Charles "Tod" Bruce after he returned home from the war, the couple married in 1947 and spent 56 wonderful years together. She went on to work as a crossing guard at McCalla School when her son Michael was in kindergarten, and later worked in several offices in the Monroe County Court House, including the County Assessor's office as well as the Auditors Office. Anna retired in 1990 after 20 years of service. She was active in her community and was a longtime member of Northside Christian Church. Anna's family was the most important thing in her life, and she loved spending time with them, especially outdoors. She enjoyed hiking, fishing, camping, and archery just to name a few. In her spare time Anna also enjoyed quilting and cross stitching. Anna was a beloved wife, mother, and grandmother. She will be deeply missed.
