



Arnold "Scott" Hutchinson

April 9, 1959 - May 5, 2023

Arnold "Scott" Hutchinson passed sleeping in his home in Bloomington Indiana, on May 5, 2023. He was surrounded by his loving wife, Margaret Lion, and dogs, Cagney and Lacey. He was born in Ashland, Kentucky April 9, 1959.

Scott graduated from Indiana University with a Bachelor of Arts in Economics and English with departmental honors. He was on the Dean's List for four years and received a Merit Scholarship for three.

To all who knew him, Scott Hutchinson was a kind, loving man who wanted to make the world a better place for all humans and animals. To make this happen, Scott became the Assistant Director for the Community and Family Resources Department for the City of Bloomington. There he worked on community programs ranging from childcare, women's shelters, housing, food programs, and even helped start HoosierNet, a non-profit Internet Service Provider for Monroe County.

It was during his work at the city that Scott perfected his grant writing skills. During his career, Scott wrote everything from local grants to competitive national grants – many of which he won. His total amount of money raised as a grant writer was \$26,533,924. You can read more about his work and impact at scottfundraiser.weebly.com.

Scott is survived by his wife, Margaret Lion, his sister Chana (Hutchinson) Weaver, brother-in-law Steve Weaver, niece Rachel, his father Richard Hutchinson and stepmother Linda Hutchinson. He was preceded in death by his mother Joanna (May) Hutchinson.
