



Baqi Zai

July 19, 1923 - August 16, 2010

BAQUI YOUSEF ZAI passed away peacefully at 7:45 p.m. on Monday. Born in Kabul, Afghanistan on July 19, 1923, he received his early education at Kabul University and his Masters' Degree in Economics and a PhD in Philosophy of Education at Indiana University. He was a fellow of the International Monetary Fund.

Baqi served as a Director of Planning in the Afghanistan Ministry of Planning and later as a governor of the Maidan and Baghlan provinces. He returned to the United States in 1969 with his family and spent his remaining active years managing a family business in Bloomington. He was a member of the Rotary Club North where he received a Paul Harris Award, and of the Toasters' Club of Bloomington. He was an enthusiastic member of the Monroe County Family YMCA for more than 25 years.

Baqi is survived by his wife Olga, his sons David, Sulaiman and Alexander, daughter Zora and 11 grandchildren. He has three surviving sisters with their families in the United States and some distant relations in Afghanistan.

The burial is on Tuesday, August 17th, 2010 at 4:00 p.m. at Little Union Cemetery, in Unionville, IN.

A separate memorial service will be held from 5:00-7:00 p.m. Wednesday at Allen Funeral Home, 4155 S. Old St. Rd. 37 in Bloomington.
