Benjamin R. Higgins, 44, of Ellettsville, passed away on Wednesday, October 19, 2022, at his residence. He was born on December 8, 1977, in Bloomington; the son of David R. and Dianna (Harshman) Higgins.

Ben graduated in 1996 from Edgewood High School and later served with the United States Navy on the USS Mahan (DDG-72) in 1996 as a Plank-owner. Ben was honorably discharged in 2000 following his time stationed in Norfolk, Virginia. He received his bachelor's degree from Indiana University, majoring in Informatics. Obtaining his degree was no easy task, he graduated with honors. Ben, being the success driven, motivated individual that he was, worked while attending school. His strong work ethic allowed to build himself up when he began his career with Catalent and most recently held the title of Principal QA Client Specialist.
