Bernice Ingram of Bloomington passed away Wednesday October 3, 2012 at Indiana University Health Hospice House, one week short of her 90th birthday. She was born in Indianapolis to Jack and Doshia Cox Ridge on October 10, 1922.

Bernice was a 1940 graduate of Smithville High School.
