Bessie Charlotte Brown, 92 of Meadowood died November 16. Bessie was born in Detroit, Michigan on May 14, 1917 to Carl and Bessie Cervený Brown. She graduated from Wayne State University completing her Masters in Nutrition and worked for the Detroit Public School System as a dietitian until she retired in 1977.
