Betty June (Albright) House Sanford of Bloomington, IN passed away at home on July 1, 2024 at the age of 68 after a 3-year battle with ovarian cancer. Betty June was born to James Eugene Albright and Betty Jane (Reeder) Starkey on December 17, 1955 in Bloomington, Indiana.

After graduating mid-year from Bloomington High School North in December 1973, she married the late David A. House of Bloomington, IN on April 7, 1974. They had four children, 8 grandchildren, and 3 bonus grandchildren. She spent many years teaching young minds at Grace Baptist Academy. Her entire life was about caring for her family and her friends.

Betty united in marriage with Timothy Sanford of Bloomington, IN on January 8, 2016. They enjoyed traveling and spending time with both of their extended families which includes a total of 6 children, 10 grandchildren, and 3 bonus grandchildren.

Betty is survived by her husband, Timothy; her children, Jennifer House of Los Angeles, Brian House and wife Amber of Indianapolis, Jason House and wife Lori of Brownsburg, Kevin House and wife Bethany of Martinsville; and many grandchildren; her brothers, Donald Albright, Phillip Albright, and Karl Starkey.

She was preceded in death by her husband, David A. House, by her parents,

by her brother, Fred Albright, and by her sister Carol (Albright) Martin.

Betty June has requested a celebration of life and a gathering of family, friends, and laughter instead of the “traditional boring funeral.” She has also requested that no one wear black or dark colors. This celebration of life will be held at Sherwood Oaks Christian Church on Saturday, July 27, 2024 with visitation at 2pm and a brief service at 3pm.
