Betty L Craig, age 84 of Bloomington passed away Saturday afternoon, November 14, 2015 at Autumn Hills Alzheimer's Special Care Center. She was born February 16, 1931 in Bloomington to Harry Farr and Gladys Perkins Farr.

She graduated from Bloomington High School in 1949 and was widely known for her lovely and talented singing abilities. Later that year she married Robert Craig, also of Bloomington on August 6, 1949 at the Fairview United Methodist Church where she and Robert were members. Following her marriage she went on to complete her Bachelors' Degree from Indiana University, where she ultimately became employed.

Betty devoted her professional career to Indiana University as a computer test technician receiving glowing remarks and accolades of her abilities both during her tenure with the university as well as in retirement. She and her husband Robert went on to become members of the United Presbyterian Church where they were both deeply involved with and committed to the Youth Group at the church.

Betty leaves behind her beloved husband Robert E. Craig of

Bloomington; son Kevin S. Craig and his wife Carolyn of Riverside, California; son Robert M. Craig of Bloomington, and grandson Christopher Craig. She was preceded in death by her parents, a daughter Kristin G. Spickelmeier, and a grandson Jay Craig Snider.
