Betty Turflinger, 88, passed away following a lengthy illness on Sunday, March 15, 2015, at the Beehive Assisted Living in Albuquerque, NM, with her two daughters by her side.

She was born on May 6, 1926 in Bloomington, Indiana to George and Violet (Breedon) Halstead. Betty was a 1944 graduate of Bloomington High School, and attended Indiana University before marrying Robert J. Turflinger on June 18, 1949.
