Brian Jay Neal, 43, of Bloomington, passed away Sunday due to injuries from a motorcycle accident. He was born on November 2, 1968 in Bloomington, IN, the son of Holland James Neal II and Rhea (Gill) Neal. Brian was a graduate of Bloomington High School North class of 1987. He had attended Indiana University and most recently Ivy Tech. Since 2004 Brian has been very active with the United States Navy Reserve.
