Brian Troy Gardner, 33, of Bloomington passed away Sunday at Bloomington Hospital. He was the son of Michael and Terrie (Hammock) Gardner born on June 28, 1977 in Bloomington, Indiana. Brian was a graduate of Bloomington High School South. He received a Bachelor's Degree in Physical Education from Indiana University and served with the National Guard. Previously Brian taught Physical Education in Nevada where he also spent his free time driving a far distance to an Indian Reservation to teach physical education to the children there and mentor them. Most recently Brian was self employed working in lawn care.
