C. Kent Carter, age 83, of Bloomington, passed away on March 8, 2013 in Lexington, KY. Kent was born to G. Kent and Ruth C. Carter in Monroe County, Indiana on September 7, 1929. He graduated from Bloomington High School in 1947 and went on to earn a Bachelor's of Science degree at Indiana University and a law degree from Temple University. He served as a lieutenant in the Army during the Korean War, and after earning his CPA, he went on to pass the Bar Exam in 1962. Kent was involved in the Shriners, American Legion, Elks, Moose, and Eagles organizations and was also a Mason.
