Candi Jo Haley, age 57 of Bloomington passed away Wednesday February 1, 2017 at the Indiana University Health Bloomington Hospital. She was born October 28, 1959 in Bloomington to Boyd and Patricia Haley. Candi spent her professional career as a public servant in Monroe County, most recently at the Prosecutors Office as a Child Support Case Worker where she received multiple Kudos Awards for her service and dedication to the children of Indiana. She was a lifelong member, leader, supporter and volunteer of 4-H; a proud supporter of the Don R. Lewis Memorial Christmas Fundraiser, the It's All About the Animals organization, and was a current member of the Richland Township Advisory Board. Candi was a lover of all things outdoors, especially humming birds, the warm sun and working in her garden. 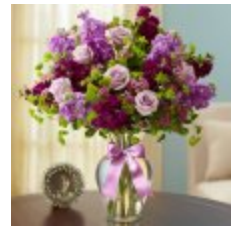
I am sadden to have to be telling of this as a memory of her sweet life....She will always be our little flower girl..

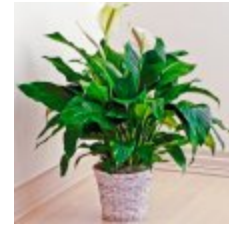
