Cecil Brock, 72, of Bedford, passed away Friday morning, January 13, 2017, at the IU Health Bloomington Hospital.

Cecil was born August 7, 1944 in Asher, Kentucky the son of John Henry and Susie (Hoskins) Brock. He was a 1962 graduate of Medora High School.
