Charles A. Farmer, of Bloomington, Indiana, died peacefully Tuesday, July 24, 2012 at Bloomington Hospital surrounded by his family.

He was born to the late Charles and Florence Farmer on September 21, 1931 in Lawrence County, Illinois. Charles married his wife of 61 years Martha (Adams) Farmer on a stormy Friday, April 13, 1951. He began his working career as a sub-city carrier at the Bloomington Post Office and advanced through sub-rural carrier and supervisor positions before serving as the Postmaster for 10 years. He retired from the post office in 1986.
