Charles Franklin "Chuck" Terrell, 68, of Bloomington died at his residence on Friday evening, June 10, 2011. He was born on January 17, 1943 in Glendale, California the son of Chester and Verla (Heinike) Terrell. He was retired from the U.S. Postal Service with over 30 years of service and worked at Meadowood Healthcare Pavilion for another 10 years with resident services. He thoroughly enjoyed driving the residents to numerous appointments or to the airport.

Chuck attended Indiana University and served with Army National Guard following graduation from high school. He was a longtime member of the Evangelical Community Church and participated with the choir.

Survivors include his wife, Christiane Jung-Terrell, his children; Andrea (Rio) Ripberger of Oregon, Wisconsin, Christina Terrell and Teresa Agredano, both of Grand Junction, CO and Charles F. He was preceded in death by his mother, Verla Terrell.
