Charles Eugene Richardson, age 85 of Bloomington, passed away at his residence, Monday morning, March 17, 2014. He was born August 30, 1928 in Monroe County to Lloyd and Mary Matlock Richardson.

Charles was the owner of C.E. Richardson Excavating Company for 46 years, and Maintenance Contractor for East Monroe, Bean Blossom Patricksburg, Cataract, Town of Nashville, Washington Township, Stipp Road and Shadyside Road Water Companies. Prior to this he worked for Indiana Bell as a cable splicer in cities as far north as Lafayette, Indiana and as far south as Evansville, Indiana for sixteen years.
