



Charles David Flowers

April 29, 1939 - May 18, 2021

On May 18, 2021, the world lost a special man. Charles David Flowers, 82, was born on April 29, 1939, in Indianapolis, Indiana. Chuck (also known as Dave to his siblings and extended family) was a pioneer in the field of computing, where his career spanned 40 years. It was a career he happened into as a mathematics major at Indiana University, where in 1963, he took the first and only course in computer science. His professor then offered him a job at the newly established Indiana Research Computing Center, where he worked for 26 years as a systems analyst before transferring to a similar role at IUPUI in Indianapolis until his retirement in 2004.

Chuck was a member of the IU Varsity Club, IU Alumni Association, and League of Women Voters. He and his wife Pam have been IU athletics season ticket holders since 1975 (basketball) and 1983 (football). Chuck loved fishing, hiking, visiting the ocean, traveling, taking long drives, puzzles of all types, and spending time with family and friends. He and Pam built their dream cabin in Brown County in 1995 and fulfilled their vision to create wonderful memories for their grandchildren.

Chuck is preceded in death by his parents, Charles K. and Margaret O. (Shirk) Flowers and his sisters Bonnie Biemer and Margaret "Buz" Krahenbuhl. He is survived by his wife of 59 years, Pamela Flowers; his children Chuck Flowers (Leslie) and Kim Evans (Trent); his grandchildren

Olivia, David, and Annie; and his siblings Jeff, Keith, and Jennifer Flowers.

Chuck was known by all for his kindness, thoughtfulness, and helpfulness. There wasn't a problem he couldn't solve. He was truly one of the good guys and made the world a better place through his warmth and humility.
