Charles Rudolph "Rudy" Tabereux, of Bloomington passed away on Thursday December 21, 2017 at 5:00PM surrounded by his family. He was born May 30, 1928 in Spencer, Indiana to the late Howard M. Tabereux and Katherine (Hickam) Tabereaux.

After graduation from Spencer High School, Rudy went to work at his father's limestone company, Midland Cut Stone Company in Bloomington. He later co-owned the company alongside his brother Howard M. Tabereux, Jr. for many years.

He was a lifelong sports fan and played high school basketball on two sectional championship teams at Spencer High School. Rudy was a member of the Indiana National Guard for many years and played on 5 state championship National Guard basketball teams. Rudy was a longtime high school basketball referee in Indiana and refereed several sectional and regional boy's basketball tournament games.

After retirement he thoroughly enjoyed playing tennis and cards with a group of close friends.

Rudy was a longtime member of the Sherwood Oaks Christian Church and will be fondly remembered for the gentleman he was, his huge heart and his

willingness to assist anyone in need.

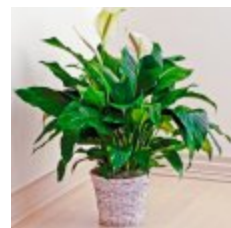
