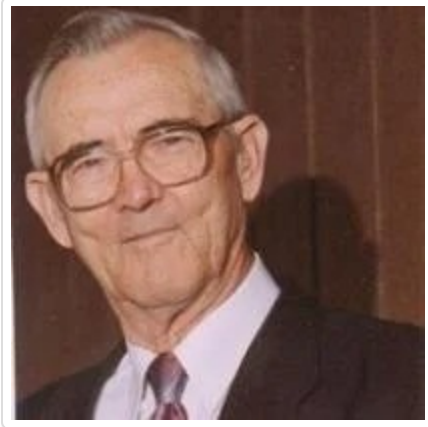




Charles Stanfield
