November 24, 1930 - June 26, 2014

Charlyn Harriet Savastuk, of Bloomington passed away at Garden Villa Health Care Center on June 26, 2014 after an 8 month battle with colon cancer. She passed peacefully surrounded by her children.

Charlyn was born on November 24, 1930 in her beloved Parkersburg, West Virginia; she was the daughter of Carl B. and Garnet B. (Hamilton) Cooper. Charlyn's family moved to Lorain, OH when she was in the 9th grade. There she completed high school and attended Oberlin Business College. Charlyn worked in a real estate office until she married.

On May 24, 1952 she married John P. Savastuk. They had 5 children together and moved to Poland, OH in 1960. Charlyn was active in the Alter Guild of Holy Family Parish, serving as its president for one year. She was also the leader of Girl Scout troop 317 for several years. She retired in 1982 from Town and Country Cleaners in Poland, OH. She and John moved to Sandusky, OH in the 90's and lived there until Charlyn was widowed. She moved to Bloomington, IN in 2009.

Charlyn was an avid reader. She enjoyed crossword puzzles,

needle work and was a fabulous cross-stitch artist She collected dolls and bells. She was a devoted Cleveland Indians baseball fan since the 1940's. She never missed watching them on television, even when they were not winning. Charlyn spent her final years at Redbud Hills Retirement Community where she enjoyed Bean Bag Baseball, Bingo and spending time with dear friends and family.

Charlyn leaves behind son David Savastuk his daughters Megan and Katie Garnet, their mother Renee Stone; daughter Susan Savastuk (Glorianne Leck); son Stephen Savastuk (Diane) their daughter Nicole; son James Savastuk and several nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by her parents, sister Mary Lou Zudell, husband John Savastuk, son Timothy Savastuk, and her companion Tomas Rivera.
