April 23, 1918 - January 5, 2015

Chester O. Terrell, age 96 of Bloomington passed away early Monday morning, January 5, 2015 at Garden Villa in Bloomington

He was born on Terrill Ridge in Brown County, Indiana April 23, 1918 to Benjamin and Martha B. (Lucas) Terrell.

He was a 1938 graduate of Bloomington High School and a veteran of WW II serving in Italy with Co. F of the 2nd Battalion of the 339th Polar Bear Regiment of the 85th Custer Division. He and his wife Verla M. Henike Terrell, to whom he was married on March 31, 1941 were long time members of Faith Lutheran Church in Bloomington. He spent his professional career with the United States Post Office retiring after nearly 37 years of service.

Chester leaves behind one daughter Glenda Morris and son in law Ernest E.
