Christ Drossos Jr. 67, of Bloomington passed away Friday, September 16, 2022 at IU Health Bloomington Hospital.

Born, December 22, 1954 in Gary, he was the son of the late Christ and Anastacia (Chakos) Drossos.

Christ was a 1973 graduate of Lew Wallace High School in Gary, IN, and he was the Owner/Operator of Clean Machine Car Wash in Bloomington.

He was a retired House Director at Acacia Fraternity, Sigma Nu and Alpha Tau Omega. He was very active in Acacia Fraternity and their Foundation receiving many awards including, The Order of Pythagoras, The Award of Merit and the George F. Patterson Jr. Award.

Christ was a DJ and radio personality "Chris Michaels" at 92.3 WTTS and WCGL 1370AM. He also announced the Little 500 Bike Race at Indiana University.

Christ was a loving father and brother who was an avid bowler, Chicago White Sox, Chicago Black Hawks, Chicago Bears, Indy Car, Formula One, and Indiana University Sports fan.

He leaves behind his sister, MaryAnn and brother, Jim both from Merrillville, IN; uncle, Tom J. Chakos in Hillsborough, CA; and numerous cousins and friends.

Christ was also preceded in death by his son, Nicholas J. Drossos.

I served as the public address announcer for IU Athletics 45 of those years and had the great fortune to work alongside Christ 41 years for what was one of Christ's great passions, the Little 500. Annually, I eagerly awaited those two days locked in a glass announcer's booth with Christ where we settled every worldly issue, had so many great discussions and brought to the assembled crowds a sterling race presentation to help them appreciate something that meant so much to Christ -- the World's Greatest College Weekend, a bicycle race. Christ shared unselfishly his passion for the race with me, and his encouragement made me sound awfully good and knowledgeable. We saw each other not often enough away from that April weekend in Bloomington. I count the days as so special when I'd stop at the Bypass Car Wash and Christ would be there. Those were some of the greatest two-hour car washes I'll ever enjoy. I've relocated to Florida, and Christ continued to reach out to me April 2022 as he prepared to go solo announcing the two 2022 Little 500 races. He was a bit nervous, but there's nobody with more knowledge of strategy and traditions about L500 than Christ. He nailed his two races with all the passion and skills he'd always shared with me. I'm going to miss my friend, Christ Drossos. May I extend to his family my sincerest sympathies.
