Christin Michelle Turner, 37, of Bloomington passed away on Dec. 16th at Bloomington Hospital. She was born on Nov. 21, 1973 in Bloomington the daughter of Steven Campbell and Susie (Davis) Rejko. She was a graduate of Brown County High School in 1991 and attended Indiana University.
