September 15, 1929 - June 29, 2014

Dale Head, age 84, of Bloomington passed away late Sunday night, June 29, 2014, at the Richland Bean Blossom Health Care Center. He was born in Bloomington on September 15, 1929 to Rufus and Cosetta (Burris) Head.

Dale was a 1948 graduate of Bloomington High School where excelled as the starting quarterback on the football team. He is also survived by one great grandchild, Adrianna Head.
