



## Dan Frank Osen

September 14, 1930 - November 16, 2017

Dan Frank Osen, age 87, of Indianapolis, formerly of Bloomington passed away Thursday evening November 16, 2017 at University Heights Health and Living Community.

Dan was born in Anita, Iowa, the older son of Eric and Florence (Rickel) Osen. He graduated from Anita High School in 1948 and went on to Graduate from Drake University College of Pharmacy, Des Moines, IA in 1952. Dan served in the US Army from 1952 to 1954, Stationed at Fort Sill, OK. While there, he met Voncile Swagerty, a 5th grade teacher in Lawton, OK. They were married in 1954 and in 1955 they moved to Indianapolis where Dan started his 33 year career with Eli Lilly as Chief, Government Bids and Contracts. Dan was a lifelong member of the Methodist Church serving in many capacities.

Dan is survived by a son, Steven Osen of Greenwood, IN, daughter, Danna O'Hare of Indianapolis, three grandsons, Eric Osen, David O'Hare, and Daniel O'Hare all of Indianapolis, one granddaughter, Allison Osen of Greenwood, One daughter-in-law, Deborah (Dietz) Osen and one great grandson, Andrew David Osen.

Dan is preceded in death by his wife, parents, younger brother Russell and son-in-law Steven O'Hare.

Dan and Voncille moved to Bloomington, IN in 1990. She died in 1998. In 2009 he moved to the Meadowood Retirement Community, Bloomington, where he was residing at the time of his death.

He was a life-long member of the Methodist Church, serving in various

capacities in several churches. He and Voncile sang in the choirs of these churches and were also past members of the Indianapolis Symphonic Choir. Funeral services will be held Tuesday November 21, 2017 at 1:00PM at University Heights United Methodist Church 4002 Otterbein, Indianapolis with visitation from 11:00AM until the time of the service at 1:00PM also at the Church. Entombment will follow in the Washington Park East Cemetery.
