Daniel Keith Clark, 75, of Bloomington, passed away on Wednesday, March 7, 2018, at IU Health Bloomington Hospice House. He was born on September 18, 1942 in Anderson, Indiana, the son of George H. and Maggie (Deckard) Clark.

Dan joined the United States Marines Corps following high school in 1960. He was stationed in El Toro, California following basic training in Pendleton, California. Dan was honorably discharged in 1964. He went on to work for Otis Elevator as a Human Resources Manager, and retired following 34 years of service.

Dan was a member of the American Legion, NRA, Gold Wing Motorcycle Club, USCCA, and Indiana Sheriff's Association. He enjoyed car shows, watching NASCAR, and motorcycles.
