Daniel H. "Dan" Jones of Bloomington, Indiana died Thursday, June 4, 2020 at the Golden Living Center. Dan was born in Hazelton, Indiana (Gibson County) to Florence and Joseph Jones.

He married his wife, Maxine Hunt, of nearly 79 years on December 31, 1940. They had 4 children, Rita Keller of Bloomington, Michael Jones of Dallas, Texas, Bev Dunbar of Terre Haute, and Max Jones of Greenwood; 12 grandchildren, and 16 great grandchildren.

Dan served honorably in the United State Marien Corp in WWII in Peleliv and Okinawa. He also served in China as part of the occupation forces disarming the Japanese garrison.

Upon his discharge, Dan became an employee of Indiana Bell/Ameritech where he worked for 39 years before retiring in 1984.

Dan was a master at gardening and remodeling. He was a man of faith and would never fail to say grace whether at the family dinner table or at McDonald's before biscuits and gravy with grape jelly.

Dan lost the love of his life, Maxine, just last November 24, 2019. Many likened their love story to that in the "Notebook".
