David Michael Curry, 65, wasn't famous or polished, but he left behind a trail of friends he accumulated humbly going about his life in Bloomington, Indiana, and before that the St. Louis, Missouri, area.

A gentle giant of sorts, he passed away early Monday morning, April 6, 2026, at Indiana University Health Center after a series of health problems.

His later years were dominated by those health problems. He never complained about them but rather used his hardships to spread good cheer to all he met. He wasn't a wealthy man yet always shared what he had with those less fortunate.

He was most notably a radio DJ and program director in the Bloomington area for stations like WBWB, WQRK, and WCLS.

His health problems deepened his faith, and he was a regular at the Ellettsville House of Prayer on Sunday mornings and never traveled without his favorite Bible devotional. He was the embodiment of Matthew 23:12 -- "Whoever exalts himself will be humbled and whoever humbles himself will be exalted."

He went back later in life and finished his college education, graduating from

Lindenwood University, St. Charles, MO, in 2013 with a degree in communications. He graduated from Pattonville High School in the St. Louis suburbs in 1978.

He was a lifelong passionate fan of the St. Louis Cardinals and later became just as animated rooting for the Indiana Hoosiers. He lived to see the football Hoosiers win the national championship at the end of the 2025 season.

Mostly, David was a good and decent man who loved his neighbors, his sports teams, and his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, in whose arms he has been delivered.

He leaves behind a brother, Dan, a sister, Laura, and a whole lot of people who admired his humble spirit. A celebration of life service will be held on Friday, May 15, 2026, at 6 p.m. at the Ellettsville House of Prayer, 4100 North Hartstrait Road, Bloomington.
