Dr. David Anthony Warzyniak DDS, age 48 of Bloomington passed away late Monday evening, September 8, 2014, at Indiana University Health Bloomington Hospital. He was born in Hammond, Indiana on September 5, 1966 to Donald and Minnie (Hacker) Warzyniak.

David received both his undergraduate degree in 1988 and Doctor of Dental Surgery degree in 1992 from Indiana University.
