David Walter Freese, 95, of Bloomington, passed away on Tuesday, March 6, 2018, at IU Health Bloomington Hospital. He was born on May 5, 1922 in Monroe County, the son of Warren and Viola (Sears) Freese.

David graduated from Smithville High School in 1940. He later went on to work for Westinghouse as an operator. He retired from Westinghouse following 28 years of service. David was a member of the Smithville Alumni Association, and helped in founding the Harrodsburg Lions Club. He was a farmer who enjoyed being outdoors, gardening, mushroom hunting, and cooking. David was a lifetime resident of Monroe County with storehouse of knowledge of local history.
