David Michael Hall, age 73 of Bloomington, passed away peacefully in his home surrounded by family and friends on Monday evening April 28, 2014. He was born in Bloomington on September 26, 1940 to Nathan and Ruth Elizabeth (Kreutzinger) Hall.

David graduated from Bloomington High School and attended Indiana University. He began his career in the stone industry as a young man in the early 60's at Victor Oolitic Stone Company where, aside from a brief hiatus as the editor of "Stone Magazine" in Indianapolis, he spent the bulk of his professional life and retired as General Manager after more than 40 years of service. Upon his retirement he continued to do independent consulting within the industry. He also served in the United States Army.

David had a variety of interests. He was an avid outdoors-man, accomplished woodworker, dog lover and prolific reader. He had a great appreciation for all genres of music and was once a member of the Indiana University Marching Hundred.
