David Duane Oney, (Ret. Bloomington Fire Captain), 70, of Bloomington, passed away on Tuesday, September 12, 2017, at I.U. Health Bloomington Hospital. He was born on December 24, 1946 in Versailles, Indiana, the son of John B. and Fonsby (McCarty) Oney.

David graduated from New Marion High School in 1964. He was a veteran of the United States Navy, serving on the USS Saratoga. David was a 34-year veteran of the Bloomington Fire Department. He started out his career in 1974 as an EMT/firefighter. David was awarded Firefighter/EMT of the Year in 1975, Snorkel Tech in 1984. Sergeant in 1989, In 1996 he was promoted to Fire Captain of station #2. David retired from the department in 2007. And was very instrumental in firefighter contract negotiations during his career. And received numerous letters of accomadations and unit citations. David was also a 40-year stage hand for Indiana University.

David was a member of Maple Grove Christian Church and IATSE #618. He was a jack of all trades who liked hard work, and enjoyed mowing his yard, movies, and traveling on road trips. He was a devoted family man who loved spending time with wife, children, and grandchildren, he will be greatly missed by all who loved and knew him.
