“ Dear Ginny, Vanita and family, I am so upset and saddened by Daves early passing. I have just recently lost two other good friend in the past few months to cancer.

I talked with Dave about 3-4 years ago and we had a great talk, He told me how he had lost a lot of weight was trimmed done, how great for him

Karyn and I moved out here about 20 years ago after closing our business in TH. I took a job as HR Director for Merillat Cabinets Manufacturing plant and was soon over seeing HR operations in all 8 SW location. Best Job I ever had.

When I called David I gave him my bad news of being diagnosed with Squamous Cell Carcinoma. I found a lump in my right neck while shaving one morning. Called my PCP and I was in the Nevada Cancer Ctr and undergoing a Right Neck Radical within two weeks. They removed 24 lymph nodes., One the size of a ping pong ball. It has metastasized into my neck and a large portion of my neck was also removed (7.5hrs surgery). and underwent 8 weeks of daily Radiation and weekly Chemo (4hr drip) The combination was BAD. Went back to work after a couple of weeks, and would occasionally throw up in my office water basket. My six month PETScan showed three more tumors in the same area so they took them out along with 5 more lymph nodes all malignant. This type of Cancer is very common in men with a 95% recovery rate. I could see I was leaning in the 5% group. Followed by Increased Radiation Levels for 8 weeks daily and increased Chemo (5.5hrs)

and still working Some shorter hour I trudged along to three Docs per month. Within a year the PETScan showed three tumors on My left neck. Yep Now they do a Left Radical (7hrs.) I am now having swallowing problems because of the collateral damage from the Radiation. I have lost Saliva glands (dry Mouth) I take water everywhere, no taste buds. I have undergone four Throat dilations to stretch my throat and can have no more. Last Jan. PETScan showed two Tumors behind my right ear in a marble size in my left lung. Had them removed and am now on Chemo with PETScan showing multiple tumors in both lungs AND below sternum.

I am getting everything ready for Karyn and the kids. I have Pic/Slide show prepared for the services at Roselayn and I believe there is a pix of David, me and Dr. Fauber in the show. Karyn and I have plots at Roselyan as well. In fact you dont even have to get out of your car our feet are just a few feet from the rd way. Just slow down and say hi. HA, HA, HA

Although I had not seen david many years I can remember our antics at Uion like it was yesterday, and who could forget our infamous deer hunting trips. We really did go deer huntin Please give my sincerest to all and if Dave and I played our cards right I will most likely be joining him shortly. Love to all...Jim
