David William Buskirk, 94, died at IU Health Bloomington Hospital on Friday, February 15, 2013. He was born October 14, 1918 in Greene County to William and Wanda (Keller) Buskirk.

Also known as "D" or "DW", David graduated from Bloomington High School in 1937 and he retired from RCA after more than 30 years of employment as a quality control inspector. He was a member of the Southern Hills Church of Christ and the former Indiana Avenue Church of Christ where he served as an elder. He was a member of the United States Army where he served in World War II, in the Philippine Islands, Artillery Division.
