Dennis Ray Koontz son of Philip Koontz and Mary Lee Koontz died on May 9th, 2023 in Bloomington, IN. Dennis is survived by his two sons Kevin (Ashley) and Scott Koontz; his two brothers Jim (Mary) and Andy (Elaine) Koontz, three grandchildren, a niece and 3 nephews.

Dennis was a resident of Bloomington, IN and a graduate of Bloomington High School. He spent his youth racing motocross and hunting and fishing. Being an avid outdoorsman, led to his future occupation as an Indiana Conservation Officer.

Dennis served in the United States Navy during the Vietnam War. He worked as a boiler room technician on the aircraft carrier the U.S.S. Coral Sea. During his time in the Navy, he was awarded the Navy Achievement Medal on July 1st, 1972.

Dennis spent 30 years as an Indiana Conservation Officer. He would eventually retire at the rank of Lieutenant. While working as a conservation officer, Dennis was chosen to attend the F.B.I. Academy in Quantico, Virginia. He would later graduate from the academy; one of his highest professional achievements.

Dennis loved to hunt and fish; his favorite place was Hayward, WI. He and his

family spent many summers at Ghost Lake Lodge where they would spend long days (and nights) fishing. He loved to trophy fish; especially for the elusive musky.
