Dolores J. Brinson, age 89 of Bloomington passed away Thursday evening, March 1, 2018 at the Indiana University Health Bloomington Hospital Hospice House. She was born July 16, 1928 in Indianapolis to Earl Smith and Adah Horner Smith.

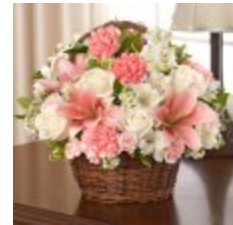
