Don R. Brummett, 90, of Bloomington, passed away on Thursday, April 16, 2020 at Garden Villa Health Pavilion. He was born on May 14, 1929 in Martinsville, the son of Howard and May (Haase) Brummett.

Don served with United States Army in the 14th Regimental Combat Team 25th Division Company B of the Korean War. He was a member of the American Legion Color Guard. Don held several jobs throughout his career that included working for Graham Motors, Barnard Motor Car Sales, Rones Music, Hays Gulf, Harry Stephens Oldsmobile, and Walmart.

Don was a long time local country and bluegrass musician with his band The Drifters. He later played in a bluegrass band called Crossfire.
