



## Donald Leroy Boruff

Donald Leroy Boruff, 89, of Bloomington, passed away on March 2nd, 2025. Donnie was born on October 3, 1935, in Bloomington, Indiana, the son of Glenn and Lilly (Floyd) Boruff, and the younger brother of Delbert Boruff.

After graduating from Solsberry High School in 1953, Donnie married the love of his life, Lucille McCombs, in Corinth, Mississippi, on July 10, 1953.

Together, they shared a full and rich life, belonging to many organizations, participating in dance clubs, bowling, and enjoying vacations and travel with close friends and family. Donnie was the owner and operator of the Marathon Bulk Plant in Bloomington.
