



## Donald Martin Fox

January 23, 1927 - January 29, 2018

Donald Martin Fox of Bloomington, IN died on Jan. 29, 2018 at 91. He was born in West Terre Haute, IN on Jan. 23, 1927 to Ernest and Nettie Gay (Price) Fox.

Don was a child of the Great Depression, loved Our Gang comedies and recalled the excitement of seeing bi-planes fly overhead. He lost his father at 10 and his mother when he was 25. He was a graduate of West Terre Haute HS. "Foxy" worked from an early age and held numerous jobs including caddy, errand boy, haberdasher, furniture sales, milkman, and insurance salesman. He had a big personality and loved interacting with people and making them laugh. From age 70 to 83 he loved working as a delivery man for Kroger pharmacy where he delivered cheer throughout Bloomington. Foxy always dressed well and sought to elevate those around him, liberally distributing compliments and encouragement. He believed in people, loved animals, especially dogs, and had a deep respect for the environment that nurtures both. Don also enjoyed golf, bird watching, and fellowship at Sherwood Oaks Christian Church. He loved his family most of all and called his wife, Lorene, his "Sunshine." The couple were married in Hollywood, CA then returned to Bloomington where they've resided for over 55 years, recently celebrating their 61st anniversary.

Donald was preceded in death by his brother Ernest, sister Mary Alice and spouse Charles Goodman-Malamuth, sister-in-law Ann Fox, nephew Donald E. Fox, and niece Edye Adkins. Donald is survived by his wife Lorene (White)
