Rev. Donald L. Robinson, 61, of Bloomington lost his battle with leukemia on October 24, 2012. Don was born June 19, 1951 in Scott County, Indiana to the late Harold A. and Madge (Watterson) Robinson. He graduated from Crothersville High School. He served in the United States Navy from 1969-1975. He was honorably discharged with the rank of Petty Officer 2nd Class. He was also a graduate of the Baptist Bible College in Springfield, MO and Andersonville Baptist Seminary College in Camilla, GA receiving a Bachelor's Degree. Don was in the ministry for over 30 years with the latest being Pastor of Grace Baptist Temple in Bloomington, IN. He pastored the church for over 22 years. He is survived by his wife Pat, son Brandon (Terri) Robinson and their children Riley Robinson and Brittany (Austin) Leiser. He also has a son Ben (Stephanie) Robinson and their children Katie, Nathan and Matthew. He leaves three great-grandchildren, Emily, Malachi and Layla. He is survived by one sister Charlotte (J.T.)
