Donna Jean (Matson) Lewis, 80, of Bloomington, Ind., passed away peacefully Thursday at the IU Health Bloomington Hospital, just one week after her husband of 51 years, Phil Lewis, passed away. Donna was born Nov. 26, 1932, in Ellettsville, Ind., the daughter of Harry and Alta (Cavaness) Matson. Donna graduated from Ellettsville High School.
