Dorothy June Taylor, 94, passed away Sunday, October 21, 2012, at Golden LivingCenter, Bloomington.

Dorothy J. Taylor was an editor and lover of the written word. She graduated from Indiana University School of Journalism, Class of 1940. She was a civilian employee of the U.S. War Department during WWII, testing radio equipment for the Signal Corp. She edited a technical engineering magazine in Detroit, before returning to Bloomington as Publications Editor, School of Education.

Dorothy was a member of First Christian Church, Life Member of Alpha Delta Pi, member of Altrusa International of Bloomington, past regent of Bloomington Chapter NSDAR, and member of other community clubs, which she served faithfully and generously with her time and talents.
