Dorothy Louise Brenton, 90, of Bloomington passed away at 11:22 pm November 10, 2015 at IU Health Bloomington Hospital in Bloomington. She was born January 9, 1925, to Mark J. Ellmore and Beulah S. Dorothy was a 1943 graduate of Covington High School in Covington, Indiana and attended Indiana State University and Indiana Central College where she graduated in 1963 receiving her Bachelor's degree in Art Education.
