Edmund Ross (Ted) Hall, died unexpectedly on March 8, 2023 at home in his sleep.

Ted was born February 24, 1940 in Louisville, Kentucky to Edmund Hall and Marian Ross Hall.

He graduated from the University of Louisville and completed a second degree at Indiana University in Bloomington, Indiana. He taught High School Chemistry and Business, followed by work at the Indiana University Cyclotron as a technician and jack of all trades.
